We understand that booklet imposition can be confusing. Our team of qualified designers are ready to set up your file in printer spreads. If you are sending a pre-designed piece, please read and implement the following tips:



document setup

the final booklet size, once trimmed and folded, should be the size of your page

number of pages

when sheets of paper are folded, there are 4 pages per sheet—every job needs to have enough pages to be divisible by 4—even if there are blank pages!

margins


to allow larger booklets to fold and accommodate creep, please leave larger margins on your center pages (at least .25")

pagination

keep all pages in order, starting with front cover, and ending with back cover

bleeds

if your booklet has a bleed, where the color goes past the edge of the paper, include a .125" slug area on 3 sides (the side that meets the center does not need a bleed)



Our software determines which pages are neighbors, such as the above example of the covers as they print.
